



Margaret J. Lehmann

September 28, 1913 - November 22, 2008

Margaret Johnson Lehmann of the Quadrangle, Haverford, Pennsylvania, formerly of Wynnewood, died November 22 at Bryn Mawr Hospital at the age of 95. Born Margaret Dale Johnson in Houston, Texas, where her father was a professor of engineering at Rice Institute (now Rice University), she graduated from the University of Missouri at Columbia and married George Putnam Lehmann in 1936. Mr. Lehmann's career with the General Electric Company took them to New York, Ohio, New England, and Philadelphia.

A homemaker for most of her life, Mrs. Lehmann later worked at the Barnes Foundation, the Shipley School, and Villanova University. She was a member of Pi Beta Phi sorority, the National Society of The Colonial Dames of America, the Daughters of the Cincinnati, and the Pennsylvania Society of New England Women.

Mrs. Lehmann is survived by two daughters, Nancy Gray of Portland, Oregon, and Ann Blum of Berlin, Germany; two granddaughters, Elizabeth and Emily Gray of Portland, Oregon; and two sisters, Whitney Chapman of Denver, Colorado, and Helen Keyser of Salem, Oregon. She was predeceased by her husband of 62 years, her daughter, Melissa Lehmann, and her brother, Ellis Johnson.

Interment at the Trousdale family plot in Madison, Wisconsin, will be private.
