



## Marilyn Elizabeth Flynn

Marilyn Elizabeth Flynn, age 65, died suddenly in her home on Presidents Day, Mon. Feb. 16, 2015. Marilyn was born in Boston, MA and attended the prestigious Girls Latin School, Regis College, and Boston College where she earned her post graduate degree. As a young girl she worked for the Boston Social Service department in many of the roughest neighborhoods of Boston offering her professional counseling to families in crisis. In 1982 Marilyn moved to Philadelphia and became a member of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange and began a career as an options trader. Before long Marilyn was drawn back to therapy and established herself as an therapist from 1988 to the present, serving clients in the Philadelphia area. She maintained her practice until the end and touched everyone she encountered with her empathy, understanding, and sound advice. Marilyn is survived by her brothers Charles and Thomas Flynn, sisters-in-laws Joan Flynn, Valerie Flynn, Jane Flynn and Anna Flynn, numerous nieces and nephews as well as 8 grand nieces and nephews. Marilyn was not only a renowned therapist, but a friend to all. She always found the best in everyone. Her enormous personality, wealth of selflessness and friendly smile will be sorely missed.
