August 29, 1929 - March 21, 2009

Mrs. Marim Pew Hamilton of Villanova, PA and Estes Park, CO, died Saturday March 21, 2009 at her home after a long illness. She was 79. The daughter of Walter C. Pew and Hannah Elliott Lambert, Mrs. Hamilton was active in many social and charitable undertakings, including co-chairing the Women's Board of Jefferson Hospital, hosting the Jefferson Jewel Benefit, organizing the Old Market Fair of Philadelphia, Head of Volunteers for Pennywise Thrift Shop to benefit Jefferson Hospital, and served for many years on the Powell House Committee. After retiring from active social life, she traveled extensively, including three field safaris to East and South Africa, and enjoyed time with her family.

She is survived by her son Rick Hamilton of Wayne, PA and his wife Madelaine Marie (nee Richardson) and their son Connor Mackenzie; her daughter, Hannah Marim Hamilton Bowton and her husband Bradley James Bowton of Doylestown, PA; and her sister, Ann Pew Curran.
