August 15, 1946 - October 1, 2022

Minjian Wang, of Merion Station, PA, beloved mother, sister, aunt, grandmother, and friend passed away peacefully on October 1, 2022, at the age of 76.

Minjian was born on August 15, 1946, in Suzhou, China to Bingzhi Wang (Father) and Yuying Li (Mother). She attended Nanjing Institute of Technology from 1963 through 1968 and received a BSc degree in Engineering. She worked as a senior computer engineer for several companies and the China Customs.

Minjian was an avid poet and painter. She has written thousands of poems and painted hundreds of traditional Chinese watercolor. She was the executive editor of the Evergreen Poem Journal (长青诗刊) and the founder of the House of Aroma Women's Poetry Society (满庭芳女子诗社). In 2019, she held her personal painting exhibition in Shenzhen, China, which was well received by the critics. Over the years, she has taught poetry and Chinese watercolor to many students. Even when she was in the hospital, she continued teaching and editing poetry.

Minjian is predeceased by her husband Limin Cai. She is survived by her older brother Qili Wang, younger sister Xiaomin Wang, son Jay Cai and wife Chang Liu, grandsons David and Andrew Cai, and nieces Qinhong Wang,

Qintong Wang and Lan Huang.

Minjian's memorial service will be held at Narberth Presbyterian Church on Thursday, October 13, 2022 at 10:00AM with public viewing starting at 9:30AM. Interment will follow at St Paul's Churchyard in Ardmore, PA.
