Myra Radziul finished her race Sunday 10/12 at 1:40 PM.

Her deep and abiding faith led her to a life of service. Christian compassion for the needs of children, the sick and the disenfranchised informed all of Myra's volunteer activities from President of Lamberton Home and School Association (HSA), officer School District Philadelphia city-wide HSA, girl scout leader, moderator Board of Deacons Overbrook Presbyterian Church, elder Overbrook Presbyterian, docent Overbrook Farms Open House, hospice volunteer, volunteer Haverford State Hospital for the Mentally Ill, and cooker of countless church meals and meals for the homeless.

Myra, ever adventurous, hot air ballooned over the Serengeti, slept in a tent in Tanzania, travelled to communist China as tourist #29 and spent time in Poland before the iron curtain fell. Of course she went to standard tourist attractions too like Amsterdam, London, Italy and California

It took a long and valiant struggle with emphysema and COPD to slow her down. Up until she was rushed to the ER on Friday she was able to live in her own home and live independently - despite the fact she was oxygen dependant.

She is survived by loving daughter Deborah Rottinger, beloved son Kevin Radziul and the joys of her life, grandchildren Jessica and Rebecca Rottinger, Nicholas and Heather Radziul.
