



## Paige Pfeilmeier Saucedo

February 1, 1976 - May 13, 2011

Paige R. Saucedo (nee Pfeilmeier), beloved daughter, sister, wife, aunt, niece, cousin, teacher, friend and soul mate left our world suddenly but peacefully on May 13th, 2011 in her home. Throughout her all too fleeting 35 years, she lived a life full of love and generosity to others. A service will be held at the Chadwick & McKinney Funeral Home, 30 E. Paige was born in San Francisco and grew up in Havertown, PA. She graduated from Haverford High School and continued on to Rosemont College. She spent her junior year at Trinity University in Dublin, Ireland and upon returning to Rosemont, graduated cum laude with a Bachelor's Degree in English and Political Science. She attended George Washington University, where she earned her Master's Degree in English and English for Speakers of other Languages (ESOL). Through her program at GWU, she worked with ESOL students at Herndon High School in Virginia and upon graduating continued as a teacher there. For the past two years, she has served as the Chair of the ESOL Department. Paige was passionate about her students and shared her gift of the love of learning with each student, influencing so many. One of her fantasies was to win the lottery and use part of it for a scholarship fund for her students. And while she is not with us to see its fruition, she is

finally getting her wish.

Paige had a unique style all of her own. This is evident when looking at pictures of her as a young child. One in particular showed Paige at about 4 years old, laden with strands of toy beads and stickers for earrings. You would not see Paige without noticing her jewelry or her signature style that she worked so well. Paige was an avid reader, loved literature, movies (especially those with subtitles), traveling and spending time with friends and her beloved cats. She adored her nephews and niece and doted on them whenever she traveled back to Havertown for visits. Paige and her mom were very close friends and they visited often, most recently sharing the trip of a lifetime to California, where they visited vineyards, Muir Woods, Alcatraz and returned to her roots, seeing the childhood home where she spent the first part of her life.

Although Paige has left us, we will take her with us wherever we go. As Paige's favorite poet, Maya Angelou so eloquently said,

"And when great souls die,

after a period peace blooms,

slowly and always

irregularly. Spaces fill

with a kind of

soothing electric vibration.
