Patricia Endy (nee Neely) of White Horse Village in Newtown Square, PA, and formerly of Phoenixville, PA, and Avalon, NJ, died peacefully on February 15th, 2021, at the age of 81, with her husband David by her side.

Pat was born on September 10, 1939, in Washington, DC, to the late Robert W. and Vera Neely. She graduated from Lower Merion High School and attended Pierce School of Business Administration. Pat worked for a short time and then became a stay-at-home mother raising a family. In 1987, she married her husband, David F. Endy. She worked with him at Seidenburg Luggage in Ardmore as a merchandiser and gift buyer. Pat had a talent for identifying gift-buying trends. In the 1990s, she had a hunch that those little stuffed animals known as Beanie Babies might be a popular item, and she made countless customers happy by ensuring an exceptionally wide selection. Pat embraced tennis, paddle tennis, and the Jersey shore, where she loved to take long walks on the sand and also to Springer's. She enjoyed river cruises in Europe and winter trips to the Caribbean.

She is survived by her husband David, sons David D. Griffiths and Mark S. Griffiths, daughter Tara G. Boland (Robb Boland), daughter-in-law Jennifer Livermore, and stepsons Andrew D. Endy (Christina Smolke), Christopher S. Endy (Cora Granata), and Stephen P. Endy (Miyeko Endy). She was also a grandmother known as "Honey Pat" to Weston Griffiths (Vicki Griffiths),

Connor Griffiths (predeceased), Reed Griffiths, and Griffin Boland; and as “Nana Pat” to Maximilien Endy, Samuel Endy, August Endy, Lars Endy, Rowan Endy, and Delia Endy. She was predeceased by her brother, Robert Neely.
