Phyllis Kline Heller was born on October 20, 1928 to Luther Kline and Helen Teaman Kline of Altoona, PA. She graduated from Altoona High School in 1946, and Beaver (now Arcadia) college in 1950. In 1950 she married Edward Heller. They were long-time residents of Swarthmore, where they raised their three children Clifford, Andrew and Cynthia.

Phyllis and Ed were lifelong members of Swarthmore Presbyterian Church, where they both sang in the choir, and involved themselves in numerous activities such as the fall fair. During that time they also had a summer cottage on Lake Nuangola, where many relaxing days and fun evenings were spent.

Phyllis loved antiquing at flea markets, refinishing and decorating old furniture, long-haired dachshunds (8 over the years) singing (she was a gifted soprano), doing projects with her special friends and entertaining. She was a long-time member of PEO Chapter P in Swarthmore, where she was involved in philanthropic projects supporting women's education. In 2004 Phyllis and Ed moved to White Horse Village in Newtown Square.

She is survived by her husband of nearly 71 years, Ed, children Cliff (Joan Anderssen), Andy (Jane Knappe) and Cynthia (Ken Ulansey), grandchildren Adrienne Heller, Brian Heller and Ben Ulansey, and great-grandson Grant Heller.
