July 15, 1924 - April 28, 2007

Robert Eugene La Mura, born July 15, 1924, died Saturday, April 28, 2007 at The Lankenau Hospital near Philadelphia. Mr. La Mura was one of 9 siblings and spent his early years in Morganville, NJ. He graduated from Matawan High School. He was a veteran of WWII, served active duty in the Navy Signal Corps on board the USS Nassau, an aircraft carrier stationed in the Pacific, and received several battle decorations. Bob was inducted by his shipmates into the Ancient Order of the Deep on August 31st, 1944. Bob earned his law degree from Seton Hall Law School, where he achieved distinction as a member of the Law Review and Debate Team and as valedictorian of his class. He was admitted to practice before the US Supreme Court and practiced law for many years in Matawan, NJ, as a Partner in the Offices of Applegate, La Mura & Horan and as a Magistrate for several townships throughout Monmouth County. He also appeared before the NJ Supreme Court and was a member of the Monmouth Bar Association. He is survived by his wife , Elizabeth Devlin La Mura, their six children, Mark, Carol, Maria, Robert, Raphael and Annie, and twelve grandchildren, and by his siblings, Leona, Frank, Richard, Alfred and Joseph.

A Memorial Mass will be held at St. James Roman Catholic Church , Red Bank, New Jersey, Friday, May 4 at 10:30am.
