Robert G. Bryans of Devon, PA., died on Monday, April 16, 2007 from complications of Waldenstrom's Macroglobulinemia, a lymphoma cancer. Mr. Bryans was born in Philadelphia and graduated from Collingdale High School. He is the son of the late Samuel F. Bryans and Mary Camac Bryans. He attended Grove City College and received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemistry in 1950. He served in the U.S. Army from 1951-1953 working on the missile programs at White Sands Proving Ground, New Mexico. While working at RCA and DuPont, he did graduate work in business administration at Drexel University.

Mr. Bryans worked for the U.S. Department of Defense from 1963 to his retirement in 1995 as a contract administrator primarily in the Government Office at Boeing in Ridley Township. At the time of his retirement, he was the administrative contracting officer on the V-22 Osprey Program.

An active member of Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church since 1968, he served on the Outreach Council and was elected to the office of Deacon. He was commissioned as a Stephen Minister in June, 2006. For many years he served on the Board of Chester Eastside Ministries, an urban ministry of the Presbytery of Philadelphia. He was a member of the National Railway Historical Society for over 50 years, enjoyed travel and was an amateur photographer.

He is survived by his wife of 40 years, Cornelia Hale Bryans; a son, Scott

Harrison Bryans of Denver, Colorado and a daughter, Elizabeth Bryans Laird(Joe) of Albuquerque, N.M.
