RUSSELL T. ("DARBY") SCOTT, On May 28, 2024, of Bryn Mawr. Devoted husband to Ann (née Reynolds), he is also survived by his sisters Elizabeth Locey and Mary Lee Morrell, his son Charles (Emily), and his grandchildren William and Elizabeth.

An emeritus Professor of Latin and Classical Studies at Bryn Mawr College—where he had taught since 1966—Darby was an archaeologist who oversaw excavations in the Roman Forum and in Tuscany, and a former Professor-in-Charge of the American Academy in Rome.

The interment will take place at Mountain View Cemetery in Camden, ME on June 8; a memorial service will be held in Bryn Mawr at a later date.
