Sandra Collette Brossman Bezar, of King of Prussia, PA, beloved wife, mother, bonus mom, daughter, sister, Aunt Nanny and Mom Mom, passed away peacefully August 29, 2024 at her home.

Sandra was born in Reading, PA, in 1946. After completing her high school education at Conrad Weiser where she was elected to the National Honor Society, she took a brave leap into the steno pool at Metropolitan Edison Corp. Her knack for reinventing herself became evident at a young age, as she was promoted through the ranks to an executive assistant. Always ahead of her time, she shifted into the world of human resources consulting in 1976, becoming an extremely successful female entrepreneur. In 1990, her calling became crystal clear - to study mind-body-spirit healing at Rosemont College's Holistic Health Studies Program. That spiritual calling quickly gained momentum, as she opened her own holistic practice, authored and published a book, 'The Power of Oneness, Live the Life You Choose,' founded a spiritual community, 'The Circle of Light' and formed the 'Circle of Light Foundation.'

The two lived life to the fullest, honeymooning in Hawaii and sharing deeply inspirational trips to Greece, France and Sedona, Arizona together. One of her greatest joys in life was the moments spent with her

grandchildren - reading, playing My Little Ponies, tickling backs, doing bath shows, taking long walks, eating sushi and having deep conversations over herbal tea.

Sandra's family and friends will most remember the unconditional love she showed for humanity, the compassionate strength with which she approached any situation and the gentle way she had with animals. Her boisterous laughter was contagious and her warm hugs gave the recipient a sense of coming home. Sandy had an innate ability to attract fellow healers and spiritual lightworkers, serving as a mentor, a healer, a friend, a soul sister and trusted confidante to thousands of people. Her silly, quirky sense of humor made anyone in her presence instantly feel comfortable.

Sandra is predeceased by her parents, John and Kathryn Brossman of Wernersville, PA. her sister and brother-in-law, Shirley and Clyde Maul and her nephew, John "Cary" Brossman.
