Sarah S. died at Dunwoody Village, Newtown Square, on September 2 at the age of 82. She was the wife of The Rev. Timothy Pickering, former Rector of the Church of the Redeemer, Bryn Mawr, and the mother of Ann H. Pickering of Newtown Square, John of Phoenixville, and Timothy, Jr., of Parkton, MD. She is also survived by six grandchildren.

Mrs. Pickering was the daughter of Alden Harwood Sulger and Harriet Remington Sulger of Rochester, NY, and the sister of Alden H. Sulger, Jr., of Greenwich, CT. She was a graduate of Smith College, Class of 1946. Her family was very active in the Episcopal Church in Rochester, where she grew up and was married in 1950, and she enjoyed Rectory life in Toledo, OH and in Bryn Mawr. She and Rev. Pickering also served a year in a village church in England: her husband had exchanged parishes with the Vicar of St. Faith's, Lee-on-the-Solent, in Hampshire. For a few years during the 1970's, she delighted in a part-time job at Wyndham, the Alumnae House of Bryn Mawr College. Mrs. Pickering suffered a stroke in Italy in 1989, but it was some years before she became severely disabled.

The service will be held at the Church of the Redeemer, Pennswood and New Gulph Roads, Bryn Mawr, on Thursday, September 6, at 3 p.m. Interment will be private in the Churchyard.
