



Stephen P. Selinger

June 9, 1950 - December 20, 2014

STEPHEN PAUL SELINGER, age 64, died peacefully after an illness at his home on December 20, 2014. He was a long-time resident of Penn Valley, PA. Growing up and living all his life in Lower Merion, he was involved in all kinds of community activities. Steve was a member of the Penn Valley Civic Association and served a term as President. He joined the Lower Merion Historical Society, was part of their board and became integrally involved with the Friends of the Cynwyd Heritage Trail and the revitalization of the Cynwyd train station. Steve was a poll watcher, committee man, a Ward Leader, a judge of elections and ran for commissioner in the township's Republican primary.

After graduating from Bucknell University in 1972, he joined his mother's company, Audience Analysts, Inc., helping to launch Medico-Media Audit which led to Dental Product Audit along with Medico-Media Audit in Canada. After the company was sold in 1981, he joined CPS Communications as Vice President of Marketing and Sales. In February, 1994, Steve joined Compas in Cherry Hill, NJ as the Vice President of Marketing and Sales. Later, he took on the role of Vice President of Media where he focused on Compas Supplier Partner relations and new product development. He possessed a remarkable knowledge of pharmaceutical products and developed hundreds of lasting professional and personal relationships throughout the industry – spanning over 40 years – and was integral and indispensable to the growth and success

of Compas.

He had a tremendous love for his church family and Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Narberth. He served as President of Church Council and is now interred in their Memorial Garden. He was on the Board of Liberty Lutheran which has recently overseen a restoration of the Hearth at Drexel on Belmont Ave.

Steve is survived by his former wife, S. Adrienne; stepchildren, April J. Cobb (Christopher) and Seamus N. Phillips; step grandchildren, Ava Phillips and Madailein, William, Shaylan and Caellie Cobb; brothers, Kenneth R. (Betsy K.) and Philip R.; sister, Nancy E. Selinger; nephew Stephen B. Selinger and niece Kristen E. Maclin; and dear friend Justine M. Jones. A Memorial Service was held at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church on Saturday, December 27th.
