Suzanne Kimball of Gladwyne, Pennsylvania passed away peacefully (but unexpectedly) on Sunday, August 4th. Born on July 30th, 1944 in Allentown, Pennsylvania, she was the daughter of Eugene F. McClafferty and Leona Marie (Gehringer) McClafferty. She was a graduate of Allentown Central Catholic High School, Hunter College, and received her MSW from the Columbia University School of Social Work.

Suzanne spent many years with her husband, Justin Kimball, in Old Greenwich, CT where she practiced social work and psychotherapy in both the public domain and in private practice. She was passionate about all living things, especially her many dogs, Orphie, Bijou, Sasha, Sophie, Annabelle, Kush, and Katie.
