



The Honorable Kenneth A. Clouse

The Honorable Kenneth A. Clouse was elected to his first ten-year term on the Delaware County Court of Common Pleas in November, 1991 and his second ten-year term in November, 2001. He is a graduate of Haverford College with a degree in Economics and of New York University Law School.

He served a five-year term as President Judge of the Courts from 2001 until 2006, during which time he handled all Orphans' Court matters. Prior to that position, he served as Liaison Judge in the Municipal Law Division, and before that, in the Civil Division, Criminal Division and Family Law Division. He presently is serving once again in the Criminal Division.

Prior to his election to the Bench, President Judge Clouse served as solicitor to the Township of Haverford, solicitor for the Delaware County Office of Employment and Training and as a Commissioner for the Township of Haverford.

Extremely active in his community, President Judge Clouse has served as an officer of various civic associations and as a member of the Board of Directors of the Greater Main Line Branch of the American Red Cross. He also served as a council member and as Financial Secretary of his church. During his years of private practice, he served as a member of the Board of Directors of the Delaware County Bar Association.

President Judge Clouse has three children. Kenneth, Jr. is a graduate of West Chester University and works for the Devereaux School; Kevin is a graduate of Kutztown University; and Christopher is a graduate of York College and the Widener University School of Law.
