Think about what your own legacy might be. There are so many careers in which we leave a legacy to our families, co-workers, or especially our students if we are teachers in some capacity. I think that what

someone leaves IN you, is far more important than what they leave TO you.

Appreciate your legacy, whether it is your vocation or your hobby, and if you can, appreciate being the beneficiary of someone else's legacy.
