Walter Lindsay Lloyd, of Wayne PA died on November 1, 2010 at 97 years old after a short illness. He was the husband of the late Marjorie Houck for 57 years before her death in 1994. In 1979, Mr. Lloyd retired as head of all coal operations for the Pennsylvania Railroad. Marjorie was the ruling passion of his life, but he also took great pleasure in fishing, golf, Penn State Football and his jobs at the Railroad.
