



Warrington B. McCullough III "Tony"

April 2, 1937 - October 23, 2024

Warrington B. McCullough III "Tony," third generation family business owner and accomplished golfer, died peacefully on October 23, 2024, at his home in Gladwyne, PA, surrounded by his family. He was 87.

Born on April 2, 1937, in Abington, PA, Tony was the eldest child of the late Warrington B. McCullough Jr. and Ruth Bowden.

Tony attended William Penn Charter School and graduated from Lawrenceville School in 1954. He went on to attend Yale University, earning his BA in economics, and graduated in 1958. He spent his four years at Yale as an instrumental member of the Yale Men's Golf team, where they won the Ivy League Championship title two years, and the EIGA title for two years. Four days after his graduation from Yale, Tony married Anne Soest Bready on June 12, 1958. Soon after, he was commissioned in the United States Air Force where he served his country for three years.

Tony and Anne then returned to Philadelphia, where he began working for his family owned automotive business JH McCullough & Son and McCullough Distributing Company. He excelled on the golf course and enjoyed spending time on the beach, fishing with family and friends.

Tony was a member of Merion Golf Club, Pine Valley Golf Club, and served as

the President of the Pennsylvania Golf Association in 1977. His memberships also included Stony Lane Club and Proclamation Presbyterian Church.

He is survived by his sister Joyce Antrim and his wife, Anne, and their three children W.B. McCullough IV "Ted" (Sarah Roy), Elizabeth McCullough Johnston, and W.R.B. McCullough "Bill" (Stephanie White) and seven grandchildren; Sadie and Ramsey McCullough, Kai, Bready and Lou Johnston, Nicole and Casey McCullough.

A private burial will be held; memorial service details to follow.
